

Pharmacy

Upon the successful completion of this course, students will be able to name, ask for and find common products on sale at a pharmacy. In familiar situations, students will greet people, ask about and understand symptoms that patients describe, fill out prescriptions and recommend the treatment that patients may need.

By inferring meaning from context and using interactive exercises to confirm understanding, students will practice listening skills and respond to simple instructions and requests for information based on the topic.

Students will complete multiple choice tests that demonstrate their ability to understand instructions and information containing vocabulary used in conversations between customers and a pharmacist in the United States.

Contrasting the written and oral form of the vocabulary used in a pharmacy, students will be able to recognize the terms and use them with ease in exercises.

Students will complete pronunciation exercises and monitor their progress, which will encourage reflection and self-assessment.
